„ [...] In addition, the high degree of efficiency also makes the Heco set extremely spirited, which quickly becomes clear from the tow truck scene in „Terminator Salvation“: How the set reproduces the crashing sounds of the scrap cars and the motorcycle robot is a real experience.“

„ [...] The HECO set gets to work in a less materialistic, but much more subtle manner, with „They Can't Take That Away From Me“ by Jane Monheit and John Pizzarelli. It reproduces Monheit's voice with a great degree of clarity and fine modulation and it establishes it neatly and firmly in the sound stage amongst the instruments. The Heco speakers reveal a lively temperament here as well; however, they also provide a welcome looseness and airiness, which makes longer listening sessions a real pleasure.“

„ [...] There is no question that the four seventeen cm woofers in the front speakers work well together, even without a subwoofer, and they create a rich, precise bass range in the room...“
